Hint: Draw everything towards yourself like a greedy person.

7) SELFISH

a) Children are encouraged to share and not be selfish with their toys.

Hint: Pull bent '3's' back at your hips like you are keeping everything for yourself.

a) When you wear glasses, you look intelligent!

Hint: Show a sharp mind with your DH '8' finger flicking off your forehead.

Hint: Tap 'F'

19) PUZZLED

a) I felt <u>puzzled</u> by the look on her face.

Hint: Pull 'X' back onto forehead.

20) SCARED, FRIGHTENED

a) My friend's dog is scared of the sound of cards being shuffled.

Hint: 'S' to '5' hands.

21) SHY

a) Gene was too shy to ask Heather to dance.

Hint: Think of a person trying to hide their head.

22) ASHAMED

a) You should be ashamed of yourself!

Hint: SHY off the cheek.

23) ORDINARY, PLAIN

a) J.K. Rowling may look ordinary but really she is a famous author!

Hint: EVERYDAY

24) SKEPTICAL

a) I am skeptical about your truthfulness.

Hint: bent 'V' under eye.

25) EGOTISTICAL, BIGHEADED

a) I can't bear listening to that <u>bigheaded</u> person.

Hint: BIG at head

26) RELIEVED

a) I was so <u>relieved</u> to have insurance when I broke my elbow.

Hint: Settle down your feelings.

27) CRAZY

a) I feel <u>crazy</u> when I eat too much sugar.

Hint: Think of the gesture used to indicate someone is crazy.

28) STUBBORN

a) My son is as stubborn as his father.

Hint: Imagine a stubborn donkey's ear.

29) CURIOUS

a) Don't be too <u>curious</u> or you may get yourself into trouble.

Hint: Wiggle an 'F' at your Adam's apple

30) DISGUSTED

a) I watch the program Fear Factor, and what they eat is really disgusting!

Hint: Think of your stomach churning.

31) STRESSED

a) Police officers live with a lot of stress everyday on the job.

Hint: Press the fist of your NDH hand down like you are applying pressure.

Hint: THINK + '5' hand with bent middle finger circle on top of NDH.

a) Ruth <u>exaggerates</u> all the time, so it's hard to believe her now. Hint: Think of the truth being stretched out.

39) ISOLATION

a) Hermits prefer to live in <u>isolation</u> from human interaction.

Hint: Hit 'I's' in front of body.

40) SUPPRESS

a) When she told me a joke in class, I had to <u>suppress</u> my laughter. Hint: Hold your feelings down inside.

41) EXPOSURE

a) Patients with anxiety are taught to practice exposure to anxiety causing situations. Hint: Flat '0' hand open to '5' hand on NDH index finger.

Hint: F-A-V (lexical)

54) NO BIG DEAL

a) It was no big deal that we were late to the movie as the previews were still playing.

Hint: Shake 'F's'

55) SMILE

a) When Monique smiles, you can see both her dimples.

Hint: Bent, closed '5' hands outline smile on face.

59) SKILL

a) Sam has basketball skills that could help him play professionally.

Hint: DH pulls off side of NDH.

60) SUFFER

a) I don't want to watch my grandma suffer through her illness.

Hint: 'A' twists down in front of mouth.
